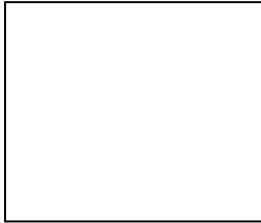
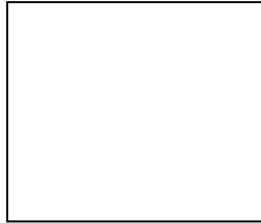


Tourist Precincts

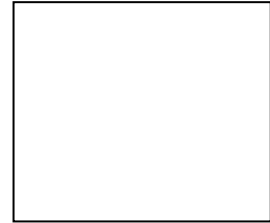

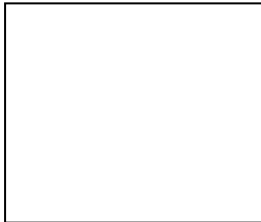
Luna Park

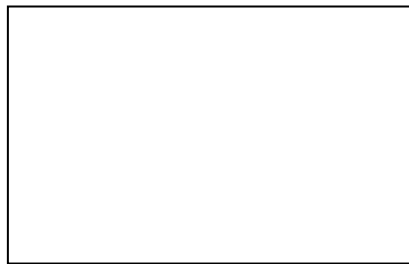
